Neil Santos was a runner-up finalist as a Cox Conserves Hero, resulting in the award of a conservation grant of \$5,000 to the PLIA. With the proceeds from this grant, a diving hookah device was purchased, enabling Neil to dive for longer periods of time to search for and mark milfoil plants for extraction.

As for prevention, our Lake Host Program must *increase hours* at both the State Park and Fundy launches. Two different lake hosts made two late season saves within a week of each other! This means we especially need volunteers for early and late season hours, since most lake hosts are college students who return to school. 


Loon, Sunset Kayaker, and Fishing tees are sold in sizes S, M, L & XL. Pick your favorite before they are gone!


